providing false or misleading information to Progressive Garden State Insurance Company for the purpose of obtaining and insurance policy, and so that Progressive would pay a third party claim; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 21st day of June 2019, entered

in the amount of \$11,334.41 against Defendant, Kristian Coffey, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; \$2,501.91 in restitution to Progressive Garden State Insurance Company under N.J.S.A. 17:33A-26; attorneys' fees of \$2,832.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
