This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4a(1), and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b), by knowingly providing false and misleading

statements to an insurance company in support of a claim, by her misrepresentations to GEICO Insurance Company in support of an insurance claim; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 27th day of August 2019, entered in the amount of \$10,140.00 against Defendant Jane L. Wilson, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the State of the New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance. This amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$4,140.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
