ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT
BY DEFAULT AS TO
SUZANNE ZANETICH ONLY

Defendant, Suzanne Zanetich ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b), by knowingly providing materially false

statements to CURE Auto Insurance ("CURE") during an application for automobile insurance by (a) fraudulently representing to CURE that an individual was her uncle in an attempt to obtain and auto insurance policy in that individual's name, and that the individual was alive at the time she attempted to obtain the policy; and (b) by fraudulently signing the individual's name to the CURE insurance application knowing that the individual was deceased.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 3 day of September 2019, entered in the amount of \$9,709.00 against Defendant Suzanne Zanetich ("Defendant"), and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for two (2) violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$3,644.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$65.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
