This court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"); and by falsely stating his vehicle had not been

in any accidents during the time his insurance policy had lapsed, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b);

entered in the amount of \$9,500.00 against Defendant Neil Neilis, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b) for one violation of the Fraud Act; attorneys' fees of \$3,500.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Neil Neilis's New Jersey driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
