


to an insurance company in connection with and in support of a claim for payment pursuant to an insurance policy knowing that the statements contained false or misleading information concerning any fact or thing material to the claim, specifically by submitting bogus receipts to an insurance company in support of a homeowner's insurance claim, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1); and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 22nd day of October 2019, entered in the amount of \$8,207.50 against Defendant, Brandon Parker, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,207.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
