Defendant, Nancy A. Pipolo ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action, and default having been entered for Defendant's failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"). Specifically, Defendant (i) knowingly conspired with another person to have her vehicle stolen so that she would

not have to make further payments on the vehicle, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(b), (ii) falsely reported to an insurance company that her vehicle had been stolen, when in fact she arranged for the theft of the vehicle, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1); and (iii) falsely reported to the police that her vehicle had been stolen, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1).

entered in the amount of \$18,626.00 against Defendant and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$15,000.00 in civil penalties for three (3) violations of the Fraud Act pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$2,561.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); cost of service in the amount of \$65.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
