This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey

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Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act") by knowingly procuring patients in exchange for remuneration, so that claims would be filed with an insurance company; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 24 day of April 2020, entered in the amount of \$6,895.00 against Defendant Albert Lee Hughes and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for four violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$895.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 \_\_\_\_\_ days of the date of receipt.
