This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1), by presenting false statements in support of a claim for insurance benefits under an automobile insurance policy with Integon National Insurance

Company ("Integon"), specifically by falsely stating to Integon that the insured vehicle was damaged by an unknown driver while parked, when, in fact, she knew she herself damaged the vehicle while operating it; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 14th day of July 2020, entered in the amount of \$6,720.50 against Defendant, Brittney Incollingo, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the Fraud Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; attorneys' fees of \$720.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.
