FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 24th day of August 2020, \$6,048.50 entered in the amount of \$9,010.50 against Defendant Elaine Kassin, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the State of the New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance. This \$2,000.00 amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$3,048.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
