ORDER OF FINAL JUDGEMNT  
BY DEFAULT

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J. Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Telge N. Peiris, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and

The Defendants, Tina Diakos and Ozkan Cengiz (collectively "Defendants"), having been duly served with copies of the Summons and Complaint in

the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendants violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and -4(a)(2) N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(b) N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(3)(a) and (b) and -4(b), by knowingly conspiring with each other, and causing to be presented false and misleading information concerning a material fact to Utica First Insurance Company ("UTICA") in support of an insurance claim for the alleged accidental fire to the property of a business, Little Mediterranean Monsters, L.L.C., d/b/a Jerzeez Diner ("Jerzeez Diner"), in violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act").

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this      day of      2023,  
entered in the amount of \$39,988.00 against Defendants Tina Diakos and Ozkan Cengiz, jointly and severally, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$30,000.00 in civil penalties for three violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$7,840.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$80.00 for Diakos and \$68.00 for Cengiz, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$2,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
