**ORDER OF FINAL JUDGEMNT
BY DEFAULT**


THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J. Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Richard E. Wegryn, Jr., Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and

The Defendant, Zumar Dubose ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend; and

This Court now finds that Defendant committed five violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act") between 2014 and 2019, as specified in the Complaint, by filing five separate claims seeking payment or other benefit from an insurance policy based upon the submission of false material information; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 28 day of Aug, 2023, entered in the amount of \$66,667.50 against Defendant Zumar Dubose, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$60,000.00 in civil penalties for five violations of the Fraud Act, attorney's fees of \$5,587.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$80.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and


