FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 17 day of JUNE 2025, entered in the amount of \$9,895.00 against Defendant Nadine E. Charles and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance.
