WHEREAS Plaintiff Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Commissioner"), and Defendant Mohdkhair M. Assi ("Defendant"), collectively "Parties," have reached an amicable agreement resolving the issues in controversy, and consent to this Agreement ("Agreement" or "Settlement").

WHEREAS the Parties have determined and hereby agree that settlement is in each of their best interests, and for good cause shown.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and obligations of the Settlement, the Parties agree fully and finally to settle this matter pursuant to the terms and conditions below.

- 1. Defendant admits that he violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), by failing to disclose his son as a resident of the household and driver of the insured vehicle on the automobile insurance application to Progressive Group of Insurance Companies dated August 24, 2021, and when adding an additional car to the existing policy on February 11, 2022, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(3) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b).
- 2. Defendant's aforementioned conduct constitutes one violation of the Fraud Act, and any future violations of the Fraud Act shall be considered subsequent violations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(c).
- 3. Defendant agrees that he shall not engage in any future violations of the Fraud Act.
- 4. Defendant shall pay a total of \$3,000.00 to the Commissioner ("Settlement Amount"). This Settlement Amount

consists of \$1,500.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); \$1,425.00 in attorneys' fees, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and \$75.00 in statutory surcharge, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

5. Defendant shall satisfy the Settlement Amount upon the following terms and conditions:

Immediately upon execution of this Settlement Agreement by Defendant, Defendant shall remit to the attorney for the Commissioner payment in the amount of \$3,000.00 by certified check, official bank check, or money order made payable to the "Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance" and sent to:

6. No representation, inducement, promise, understanding, condition, or warranty not set forth in this Agreement has been made to or relied upon by Defendant in agreeing to this Settlement. Defendant represents that this Agreement is freely and voluntary entered into without any degree of duress or compulsion.

- 7. The Parties agree that each Party shall bear its own legal and other costs incurred in connection with this matter, and no additional attorneys' fees or costs shall be due, except Defendant agrees to pay Plaintiff's attorneys' fees as described above in paragraph 4, and all reasonable costs of collection and enforcement of this Agreement, including attorneys' fees and expenses.
- 8. For purposes of construction, this Settlement shall be deemed drafted by all Parties to this Settlement and therefore shall not be construed against any Party for that reason in any subsequent dispute.
- 9. The undersigned counsel and any other signatories represent and warrant that they are fully authorized to execute this Settlement on behalf of the persons indicated below.

- 11. This Settlement may be executed in counterparts, each of which constitutes an original and all of which constitutes one and the same agreement.
- 12. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-10(c), a copy of this Stipulation of Settlement shall be provided to any appropriate licensing authority.
- 13. This Stipulation of Settlement, may be used in any subsequent civil or criminal proceedings.
- 14. The penalties of this Settlement are imposed pursuant to the police powers of the State of New Jersey for the enforcement of the law and protection of the public health, safety, and welfare, and are not intended to constitute debts which may be limited or discharged in a bankruptcy proceeding.
