This Court now finds that the Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(3), by knowingly making two materially false statements to the Progressive Garden State Insurance Company ("Progressive") on August 2, 2021, and August 4, 2021, in support of a claim for benefits for reimbursement from her automobile insurance policy for the cost of a windshield damage repair to her insured automobile by knowingly presenting a false date of loss in order to secure additional coverage; and

It is on this ^{31st} day of October, 2025;


ORDERED, that Summary Judgment shall be and hereby is **GRANTED** in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Final Judgment is hereby entered in the amount of \$11,000.00 against the Defendant, Stacy Grooms, and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for two violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of ^{3917.50}~~\$5,000.00~~, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant driving privileges of Stacy Grooms will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this Final Judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served on all parties
within 7 days from the date of receipt.
