**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT BY
DEFAULT**

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J. Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Anna M. Lascurain, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and


Defendant, Shakirah Robinson (“Defendant”), having been duly served with a

copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that the Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b) and – 4(a)(5), by knowingly providing false and misleading material information to Progressive Group of Insurance Companies ("Progressive") in support of an application to reinstate her policy for automobile insurance coverage, and by failing to disclose that she had been involved in a motor vehicle accident while operating the insured vehicle during the time in which her policy had lapsed;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 17th day of November 2025, entered in the amount of \$10,282.50 against the Defendant Shakirah Robinson and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of a \$6,000.00 civil penalty for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$4,282.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 days of the date of receipt.
