**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT BY
DEFAULT**

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J. Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Richard E. Wegryn, Jr., Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by

default; and

Defendant, Darielis Cruz-Gomez ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;


This Court now finds that the Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b) and -4(a)(5), N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and - 4(a)(3)(a) and (b), by knowingly failing to disclose that she had just been involved in an automobile accident with the vehicle to be insured when she submitted an application to Progressive Direct Auto ("Progressive") for an automobile insurance policy covering the vehicle on April 3, 2021, and by subsequently knowingly misrepresenting the date of loss to Progressive as part of application for the payment of benefits for damages from the accident to bring the loss within the effective period of coverage for the new policy;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 23rd day of January 2026 entered in the amount of \$7,575.00 against Defendant Darielis Cruz-Gomez and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for two violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$1,575.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the

date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 days of the date of receipt.
