**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT BY
DEFAULT**

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Jennifer Davenport, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Richard E. Wegryn, Jr., Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman,

Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and


Defendant, Tina M. Dellapenna f/n/a Tina M. Hock ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b) and - 4(a)(5), by knowingly concealing material information and/or made false and misleading material statements to Citizens United Reciprocal Exchange ("CURE") by failing to disclose all household resident drivers on her initial application for an automobile insurance policy dated July 26, 2018, and on subsequent renewals of the policy issued in response to the application;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this **18TH day of March 2026**, entered in the amount of \$7,657.50 against Defendant Tina M. Dellapenna f/n/a Tina M. Hock and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorney's fees of \$1,657.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A.

17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
