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This matter having been opened to the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance

("Commissioner") of the Department of Banking and Insurance ("Department") of the State of
New Jersey, by the submission of a complaint against AIG Property Casualty Company ("AIG"),
a foreign insurance company authorized to transact business in New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A.

17:32-1 et seq., regarding non-renewal of a homeowners insurance policy; and

IT APPEARING that N.J.A.C. 11:1-20.2 (g) provides that no non-renewal notice shall be valid unless the notice contains the standard or reason upon which the termination is premised and specifies in detail the factual basis upon which the insurer relies; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that AIG issued twenty notices of non-renewal to New Jersey policyholders that did not contain the information required by N.J.A.C. 11:1-20.2 (g); and IT FURTHER APPEARING that AIG:

- 1) Has admitted responsibility for the aforementioned violation;
- 2) Has cooperated with the investigation conducted by the Department; and

3) Has agreed to offer reinstatement to the twenty policyholders who received the defective notices of non-renewal:

and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that good cause does exist under <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 17:33-2 to impose a fine; and

IF FURTHER APPEARING that AIG has waived its right to a hearing on the aforementioned violations and has consented to payment of a fine in the amount of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00); and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS on this

ORDERED AND AGREED that AIG pay a fine in the amount of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) by check made payable to the State of New Jersey, General Treasury due and payable immediately upon the execution of this Consent Order by AIG; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED that the signed Consent Order together with the fine payment shall be transmitted to:
