This matter, having been opened by the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance ("Commissioner"), State of New Jersey, upon information that Alduha Sadat Safforld ("Respondent"), formerly licensed as a resident producer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-32, may have violated various provisions of the insurance laws of the State of New Jersey: and

WHEREAS, Respondent is subject to the provisions of New Jersey Insurance Producer Licensing Act of 2001, N.J.S.A. 17:22A-26 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2) an insurance producer shall not violate any insurance laws, or violate any regulation, subpoena or order of the Commissioner or of another state's insurance regulator; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (5) an insurance producer shall not intentionally misrepresent the terms of an actual or proposed insurance contract, policy or application for insurance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (8) an insurance producer shall not use fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrate incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of insurance business in this State; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 2, 2013, the Respondent submitted a life insurance application to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (MetLife) for proposed insured YM that did not contain the genuine signature of the insured, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2), (5), and (8); and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2013 and October 2, 2013, the Respondent submitted two applications on the life of proposed insured YM to MetLife whereby he asserted that he was present and had witnessed the insured's signing of the two applications, when in fact, he was not present when the insured's signatures were placed onto the two applications, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2), (5), and (8); and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2013, the Respondent submitted an application on the life of proposed insured YM whereby he asserted that the application had been signed by the insured in New Jersey, when it was known that the insured had actually signed the application in her resident state of New York, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a (2), (5) and (8); and

WHEREAS. Respondent:

- 1) Has admitted responsibility for aforementioned violations; and
- Has cooperated with the investigation conducted by the New Jersey
   Department of Banking and Insurance; and

WHEREAS, this matter should be resolved upon the consent of the parties without resort to a formal hearing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS on this

ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a, the Respondent consents to the revocation of his resident insurance producer license, Reference Number 1321837, and said license shall be immediately returned to the Department upon execution of this Consent Order, and sent to the attention of;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 11:17D-2.7, the Respondent is barred from reapplying for an insurance producer license for a period of five years from the date of the Commissioner's issuance of this Consent Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that the provisions of this Consent Order represent a final agency decision and constitute a final resolution of the violations contained herein; and IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that the Respondent shall cease and desist from engaging in the conduct that gave rise to this Consent Order.
