This matter, having been opened by the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance ("Commissioner"), State of New Jersey, upon information that Steven Ray Turner ("Respondent"), formerly licensed as a nonresident individual insurance producer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-34a, may have violated various provisions of the insurance laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Respondent is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Insurance Producer Licensing Act of 2001, N.J.S.A. 17:22A-26 to -48 (the "Producer Act"), the provisions regulating Unfair Trade Practices, N.J.S.A. 17B:30-1 to -23, and the regulations governing Insurance Producer Standards of Conduct, N.J.A.C. 11:17A-1.1 to 11:17D-2.8; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a, the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license, and may levy a civil penalty, for a violation of the Producer Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40d, the Commissioner shall retain the authority to enforce the provisions of and impose any penalty or remedy authorized by the Producer Act and Title 17 of the Revised Statutes or Title 17B of the New Jersey Statutes against any person who is under investigation for or charged with a violation of the Producer Act or Title 17 of the Revised Statutes or Title 17B of the New Jersey Statutes even if the person's license or registration has been surrendered or has lapsed by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(2), an insurance producer shall not violate any insurance law, regulation, subpoena or order of the Commissioner or of another state's insurance regulator; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(8), an insurance producer shall not use fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrate incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of insurance business in this State or elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-42(a), any insurer authorized to transact business in this State may, by written contract, appoint as its agent, a person that holds a valid insurance producer license issued in accordance with the provisions of the Producer Act; the contract shall authorize the insurance producer to act as an agent for the appointing insurer for all lines of insurance for which the insurer is authorized in this State and the agent holds authority in this State, unless specifically limited; the contract shall contain the duties, responsibilities and limitations of authority between the agent and the appointing insurer, and the agent shall abide by its terms; and

WHEREAS, on or about December 5, 2012, the Respondent submitted two life insurance applications each for insureds MM and KM to Sagicor Life Insurance Company ("Sagicor") that were misrepresented and presented as a college funding plan, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(2) and (8); and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned applications were signed by the Respondent indicating that he had personally met with the insureds, when in reality, he had completed the applications electronically and failed to disclose required information to Sagicor that the life insurance was to be financed, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(2) and (8) and N.J.S.A. 17:22A-42a; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent:

- 1) Has admitted responsibility for the aforementioned violations; and
- Has cooperated with the investigation conducted by the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Department"); and

WHEREAS, this matter should be resolved upon the consent of the parties without resort to a formal hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS on this Orday of , 2018

ORDERED AND AGREED, that the Respondent consents to the revocation of his nonresident insurance producer license, Reference Number 1239118, pursuant to N.J.SA. 17:22A40a, and said license shall be immediately returned to the Department upon execution of this
Consent Order by the Respondent, and sent to the attention of:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 11:17D-2.7, the Respondent is barred from reapplying for an insurance producer license for a period of five years from the date of the Commissioner's issuance of this Consent Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that the provisions of this Consent Order represent a final agency decision and constitute a final resolution of the violations contained herein.
