This matter, having been opened by the Commissioner of Banking and Insurance ("Commissioner"), State of New Jersey, upon information that Christopher T. Ross ("Respondent"), currently licensed as a resident individual insurance producer, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-32a, may have violated various provisions of the insurance laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Respondent is subject to the provisions of the New Jersey Insurance

Producer Licensing Act of 2001, N.J.S.A. 17:22A-26 to -48 ("the Producer Act"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(2), an insurance producer shall not violate
any insurance law, regulation, subpoena or order of the Commissioner or of another state's
insurance regulator; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-40a(18) an insurance producer shall notify the Commissioner within 30 days of his conviction of any crime, indictment or the filing of any formal criminal charges, or the suspension or revocation of any insurance license or authority by a state,

other than this State, or the initiation of formal disciplinary proceedings in a state, other than this State, affecting the producer's insurance license; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22A-47(b), within 30 days of the initial pretrial hearing date, an insurance producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the insurance producer taken in any jurisdiction. The report shall include a copy of the initial complaint filed, the order resulting from the hearing and any other relevant legal documents; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 27, 2018, the Respondent was arrested by the Lacey Township Police Department on charges of impersonation; theft of identity, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-17a(4); and

WHEREAS, on or about May 22, 2018, in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:43-12 and N.J.S.A. 2C:43-13, the Respondent was ordered by New Jersey Superior Court into Supervisory Treatment-Pretrial Intervention; and

WHEREAS, the Respondent failed to report his arrest and order for Supervisory

Treatment-Pretrial Intervention to the Commissioner within 30 days, in violation of N.J.S.A.

17:22A-40a(2) and (18); and

WHEREAS, the Respondent:

- 1) Has admitted responsibility for the aforementioned violations; and
- 2) Has cooperated with the investigation conducted by the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Department"); and

WHEREAS, this matter should be resolved upon the consent of the parties without resort to a formal hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS on this / fix day of

ORDERED AND AGREED, that the Respondent's resident insurance producer license,

Reference Number 1644230, is revoked pursuant to N.J.SA. 17:22a-40a, and said license shall be immediately returned to the Department upon execution of this Consent Order by the Respondent, and sent to the attention of;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that pursuant to N.J.A.C. 11:17D-2.7, the

Respondent is barred from reapplying for an insurance producer license for a period of five years

from the date of the Commissioner's issuance of this Consent Order; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND AGREED, that the provisions of this Consent Order represent a final agency decision and constitute a final resolution of the violations contained herein.
