WHEREAS Respondent Joann C. Torcasio, a licensed real estate broker licensed by the State of New Jersey, is subject to the provisions of the Real Estate Brokers and Salesperson's Act, N.J.S.A. 45:15-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS at all times relevant hereto, Respondent Torcasio was previously licensed as broker of record of Beach to Bay, LLC d/b/a Re/Max Platinum Properties whose office was located at 7815 Atlantic Avenue, Margate, NJ. She is currently licensed as a broker-salesperson with Carrington Real Estate Services, LLC, whose main office is located at 309 Fellowship Road, Mount Laurel, NJ 08054; and

WHEREAS the Real Estate Commission has secured evidence which indicates that Respondent Torcasio has violated certain provisions of the laws and regulations governing the conduct of New Jersey real estate brokers and salespersons as referenced above; and

WHEREAS the Commission and Respondent Torcasio have agreed to settle this matter in lieu of any further administrative action; and

WHEREAS Torcasio admits that she acted in violation of N.J.A.C. 11:5-4.4 by failing to supervise a salesperson under her employ, specifically in that a salesperson within her firm had failed to place into escrow the buyer's deposit for the property at 28 Grandville Avenue, Margate; and

WHEREAS Respondent Torcasio acknowledges that she has been made aware of her right to a full and formal hearing on any violations which the Commission may allege she has committed and her right to have the advice of counsel on the matters to which this Consent Order pertains, she is knowingly and voluntarily waiving the right to a hearing and counsel; and

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED TO BY THE PARTIES AND SO ORDERED that

Respondent Torcasio agrees to pay a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00; and it is further ordered and agreed that

Respondent Torcasio shall pay the fine within 30 days of the date of acceptance of this Consent Order. The fine shall be payable by certified check, cashier's check or money order payable to the "State of New Jersey" and sent to:

And it appearing that this matter can be resolved upon the consent of the parties, without resort to any other further administrative proceeding;
