TITLE DESCRIPTION	Under direction of Chief Examiner, Financial Examiner 4 or other supervisor in the Department of Banking and Insurance, performs the routine detailed work involved in the examination of books, accounts, and records of financial institutions, and various organizations, or persons chartered or licensed by the department; does other related duties as required.				
	The primary goal of the Depositories Group of the Division of Banking is to supervise and regulate State Chartered institutions. The Group is comprised of two units. The Examination and Enforcement Unit conducts Safety and Soundness (S&S) reviews to ensure the New Jersey banks are operating safely and able to support the local economy The Applications, Corporate Filings & Surveillance Unit is responsible for processing various banking related applications, administering New Jersey public deposit program in accordance with the GUDPA Act, and conducting off-examination surveillance on the state-chartered banks and credit unions as well as participating public depositories.				
	The Financial Examiner Consultant will be assigned to assist either or both Units, depending on the Group needs and qualification of candidate. Examination related assistance will include CAMELS evaluation tasks (Capital Adequacy, Management, Earnings, Liquidity, and Sensitivity to Market Risk) during an examination. The incumbent shall have the ability to independently evaluate the Asset Quality at an depository institution including grading or classifying loans and to meet with institution officials and/or board of directors to discuss the findings of examinations and obtain commitments for correction of deficiencies. Assist newer examiners in the learning the process of talking to institution officials. Applications and surveillance related assistance will include analyzing the Call reports, Reports of Examination, audited financials, and other bank filings to identify operational trends pertaining to CAMELS components, follow up with bank management for significant variances and collaborate with the field examiners to recommend remedial actions. The incumbent may also participate in the review of complex banking applications such as de novo bank charter, charter conversion, and merger and acquisition etc.				

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in business administration, finance, economics or accounting including or supplemented by nine (9) semester hour credits in accounting. EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS	Two (2) years of experience as a regulator examining or auditing regulated financial institutions or, accounting or auditing experience in a regulated financial institution including, but not limited to a bank, savings and loan association, and/or credit union.	
LICENSE REQUIREMENTS	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.	

	The "New Jersey First Act," <u>N.J.S.A. 52:14-7 (L. 2011, Chapter 70)</u> effective September 1, 2011, contains new residency requirements for public officers and employees, unless exempted under the law. Current, new or prospective employees should be aware of the following:
RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS	Effective September 1, 2011, all employees of State and local government must reside in the State of New Jersey, unless exempted under the law. If you already work for State or local government as of September 1, 2011, and you do not live in New Jersey, you are not required to move to New Jersey. However, if you begin your office, position or employment on September 1, 2011 or later, you must reside in New Jersey. If you do not reside in New Jersey, you have one year after the date you take your office, position or employment to relocate your residence to New Jersey. If you do not do so, you are subject to removal from your office, position or employment.
