Notice of Action on Petition for Rulemaking

Automobile Physical Damage Insurance Inspection Procedures

N.J.A.C. 11:3-36.4

Petitioner: Property Casualty Insurers Association of America

Authority: N.J.S.A. 52:14B-4(f) and N.J.A.C. 1:30-4.2

**Take notice** that on April 20, 2009, the Department of Banking and Insurance (Department) received a petition for rulemaking from the above petitioner. The Petition requests that the Department amend its rules regarding Automobile Physical Damage Insurance Inspection Procedures so as to expand the circumstances under which an insurer may waive an otherwise mandatory inspection of a vehicle. In accordance with N.J.A.C.11:1-15.3(a), the Department mailed to the petitioner, and filed with the Office of Administrative Law, a notice of receipt of the petitioner's request. The Department published the notice of receipt of the petition on June 1, 2009 in the New Jersey Register at 41 NJR 6111.

**Take further notice** that this petition was considered by the Department. The Department is still reviewing the merits of the petitioner's suggested amendments. Therefore, pursuant to the N.J.A.C. 1:30-4.2 and 11:1-15.3, the Department has determined to refer this

matter for further deliberation and will, within 90 days, finalize a notice of action on the petition for rulemaking by the Property Casualty Insurers Association of America.
