**ORDER GRANTING PRO HAC VICE  
ADMISSION TO KEVIN P.J. SCURA**

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THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Commissioner on the application of Marshall D. Bilder, an attorney of the state of New Jersey, under N.J.A.C. 1:1-5.2 to permit the appearance pro hac vice of Kevin P.J. Scura in the above-captioned matter. Kevin P.J. Scura is admitted to practice law in New Hampshire, Massachusetts, and New York. Kevin P.J. Scura is a senior associate of the law firm of Rath, Young, and Pignatelli, P.C., located at One Capital Plaza in Concord, N.H. 03302.

The affidavit of Kevin P.J. Scura indicates that he satisfies each of the conditions for admission, including good cause, set forth in R. 1:21-2(a) and that payment will be made to the New Jersey Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection and Ethics Financial Committee pursuant to R. 1:28-2.

Therefore, I ORDER that the motion seeking the admission of Kevin P.J. Scura to practice before the Department of Banking and Insurance pro hac vice in the above-captioned

matter is hereby granted, provided that Kevin P.J. Scura shall:

1. Abide by the Uniform Administrative Procedural Rules and all applicable New Jersey court rules, including all disciplinary rules;
2. Consent to the appointment of the Clerk of the Supreme Court as agent upon whom service of process may be made for all actions against him or his firm that may arise out of participation in this matter;
3. Notify the Department of Banking and Insurance immediately of any matter affecting his standing at the bar of any other court or administrative tribunal; and
4. Have all pleadings, briefs and other papers filed with the Department of Banking and Insurance signed by an attorney of record authorized to practice in this state, who shall be held responsible for the admitted attorney and for the conduct of this case and of the admitted attorney therein.
