What is Our Shared Waters

Our Shared Waters is a collective effort of Delaware River Basin stakeholders (water users, businesses, non-profits and government) to educate the public and decisionmakers about the current state of the Basin and the opportunities available to support its continued sustainability now and for future generations. The program includes:


A Collective, Ongoing Evaluation of the Basin's Waters. While the Delaware River Basin Commission produces a "State of the Basin" report every five years, it is limited to the DRBC's views and focused on the main stem Delaware River. Our Shared Waters will include an online site that lets Basin-related organizations and private citizens provide their evaluation of the various waterways within the DRB. Comments, reports, papers, photos and web links may all be included in the entry.
