## RESOLUTION NO. 80-14

A RESOLUTION extending the experimental modification of release schedules from Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink Reservoirs.

WHEREAS, on May 25, 1977, the Commission approved modification of the release schedule for Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink reservoirs on an experimental basis for a two-year period, and further extended its approval on March 28, 1979 for an additional one year; and

WHEREAS, said approval shall expire May 31, 1980 unless extended by agreement of all parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties to the 1954 Supreme Court decree are participating in good faith discussions relating to interstate management of the waters of the Delaware River Basin, including consideration of augmented conservation releases from Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink reservoirs; and

WHEREAS, such good faith discussions are expected to be concluded within the near future; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Delaware River Basin Commission:

- The experimental modification of the release schedules of Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink reservoirs, pursuant to Docket No. D 77-20 and Resolution No. 79-8, are extended from May 31, 1980 to July 31, 1980.
- 2. This resolution is contingent upon the unanimous consent of the parties to the U. S. Supreme Court decree entered in New Jersey vs. New York, 347 U. S. 995 (1954) which shall be set forth in a memorandum of agreement to be filed with the Delaware River Master.
