 - If your project is in the Southeastern Pa. Ground Water Protected Area (GWPA), [review the GWPA Applicant](#)
 - This application is to be filled in electronically
- [Discharge Application](#) (pdf)
 - For new applications, re-rates, renewals or modifications
 - This application is to be filled in electronically
- [Application for Consumptive Use Projects](#) (pdf)
 - For electric generating or cogenerating facilities designed to consumptively use in excess of 100,000 GPD of consecutive 30-day period
 - This application is to be filled in electronically


Steps for Completing DRBC's Electronic Application Submission Process

1. Download and complete the appropriate application form from among the hyperlinks above.
2. Assemble the completed application form and attachments in one or more files.
3. Go to [applications.drbc.net](#) and select "Create Account" to create a new account. Once you have established an account on [applications.drbc.net](#) and "Sign in" to your account.
4. After you have signed in, upload the completed application and accompanying materials. You may add or remove files to your account as necessary. DRBC staff will be automatically notified that your materials have been submitted.
5. Payment of the Application Fee is required by a check payable to "Delaware River Basin Commission". Please follow the instructions on the [Application Fee Form](#). The completed fee form and payment should be mailed together to:



The Delaware River Basin Commission (DRBC) was created on October 27, 1961, when concurrent compact legislation ratified by Delaware, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania and the U.S. Congress became law. This portal automates the process to apply for permits in accordance with Section 10.3 of the Compact and the Commission's Southeastern Pennsylvania Ground Water Protected Area Regulations.
