
Groundwater Sources






Groundwater Sources

Regulatory Authority - wells

- Registration, reporting and record keeping under Chapter 110 Regulations
- All public water supply wells and those >= 10,000 gpd other sectors
- Approval of water management plans for withdrawals from unconventional gas well operations



Regulatory Authorities - wells

Chapter 109 Safe Drinking Water

Public Water Supply Manual and Chapter 109 Regulations

- Capacity
- Treatment
- Aquifer Testing
- WQ Monitoring

Drinking Water Source Protection

Source Water Assessment and Protection Program (SWAP)

 Voluntary Water Protection Plans



Water Well Drillers Licensing

- Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) Program
- Well Drillers are licensed through an Act 610 registration of drillers and their rigs
- Well records submitted to database

Regulatory Comparisons

PA DEP

- Registration/reporting from wells > 10,000 gpd
- No allocations
- Approvals of Unconventional gas operator water management plans (none so far in DRB)
- Chapter 109 Permitting of public water supply wells - may involve treatment
- No regulation over other sectors
- Voluntary source water protection
- Water well drillers licensing (DCNR)

DRBC

- Registrations and reporting via admin agreements with states
- Approval/allocations for sources > 100,000 gpd outside SEPA GWPA
- Approvals/allocations for wells
 >10,000 gpd in SEPA GWPA
- Basin withdrawal limits
