Important Dates

Mark your calendars! Testing takes place during the following windows:

Testing Window March 16 – April 1, 2026

Districts may make use of the full testing window to administer the statewide assessments. This includes the original testing window and the previously identified make-up testing window. Specific testing dates are determined by each school district.



What is the purpose of the NJGPA-A and what does the test cover?

The NJGPA-A is given to all 11th graders to measure if they are graduation ready in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.

The ELA component is aligned to [Grade 10 standards](#), and the mathematics component is aligned to [Algebra I](#) and [Geometry](#) standards.

The NJGPA-A satisfies New Jersey's graduation assessment requirement while maintaining multiple pathways for students who do not pass, including retesting, approved substitute assessments, and the portfolio appeals process.
