English Language Learner Requirements for the Every Student Succeeds Act

To assist in the implementation of New Jersey's *Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)* state plan for schools with English language learners (ELLs), the New Jersey Department of Education's (NJDOE) Office of Supplemental Educational Programs prepared the *English Language Learner Entry and Exit* document, which was released via NJDOE Broadcast on March 28, 2019. The *English Language Learner Entry and Exit* document supports school districts with meeting the federal requirements in *ESSA* Section 3102. Today the NJDOE is announcing that the standardized home language survey, Parent ELL Placement, Continuation, and Exit Letters referred in the *English Language Learner Entry and Exit* document are now available in English and 20 other languages frequently spoken by New Jersey ELLs.

The documents are available on the Department's <u>Bilingual-ESL State and Federal Policy webpage</u>, under the "ELLS and ESSA" link.

Districts must use the Home Language survey; the words and content may not be altered. The parent letters are suggested templates only, and may be modified as long as the letters contain all the <u>parent notification</u> requirements.
