Release of McKinney-Vento Grant Application on NJDOE Homeroom

The New Jersey Department of Education's (NJDOE) Division of Student Services are pleased to announce the release of the McKinney-Vento Education of Homeless Children and Youth Competitive Grant application. The application due date is June 2, 2020.

The NJDOE has established a three-year grant program which focuses on the provision of instructional services that are supplemental to the regular school program, as well as referral services to appropriate community-based organizations. This grant program is open to Local Education Agencies (LEA) that apply in partnership with an organization with a record of providing services to homeless populations. Projects will coordinate and provide educational programs and services for homeless children and youth residing in the partnership's project area. Based on the availability of federal resources, this three-year grant program will begin July 1, 2020 and end on June 30, 2023. The initial award year will be July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
