The SSDS collects incidents of violence, vandalism, weapons, substance use, harassment, intimidation and bullying (HIB) and other incidents leading to removal, as well as HIB trainings and programs conducted to support anti-bullying efforts.

COVID-19 Update:

Incidents and HIB trainings and programs that occurred while schools were operating virtually should be included in the 2019-20 submission.
