NJDEP Provides Guidance for Implementing a Flushing Program in Schools

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has issued guidance for implementing flushing programs at school facilities.

Flushing removes water that has been stagnant in the water outlet and/or interior plumbing, depending on the duration of flushing. The NJDEP and the New Jersey Department of Education strongly recommend that all schools review this guidance and implement a flushing program for school facilities that have experienced and/or are continuing to experience significantly low water usage due to COVID-19-related school closures.
