Donated Hand Sanitizer Available for Distribution

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Donations Office received a large quantity of hand sanitizer that is available for immediate distribution. The following information describes the available products:

- Plastic bottles of hand sanitizer available in 50 ml., 3 oz., 8 oz., 12 oz., 30 oz., and 34 oz. sizes
- LEAs must have the capacity to accept full truckloads. Each truckload contains 26 pallets. Orders must be placed in quantities by truckload/size bottle:
 - o 50 ml. (1.7 oz.) 269,568 units per truckload
 - o 3 oz. 144,144 units per truckload
 - o 8 oz. 59,904 units per truckload
 - o 12 oz. 112,320 units per truckload
 - o 30 oz. 17,160 units per truckload
 - o 34 oz. 18,720 units per truckload
- The hand sanitizer is a moisturizing formula containing 62 percent alcohol, with a September 2022 expiration date.

LEAs that would like to request a supply of hand sanitizer should complete the <u>request form</u> and <u>hold harmless</u> <u>agreement</u>. Completed forms must be sent to <u>FEMA-Donations-Mgt@fema.dhs.gov</u> with the subject line: *Hand Sanitizer Donation*. Supplies are available for immediate shipping, but quantities may be limited. Interested LEAs are encouraged to apply as soon as possible. Please note: Delivery of the product will be provided by the donor; if the requested size is not available, the donor reserves the right to substitute with a different size.
