## 2020-2021 ACFR and Audit Summary Submission

On October 27, 2021, Governor Phil Murphy signed P.L.2021, c.256 (<u>S3881/A5834</u>), extending the required completion date for the 2020-2021 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) (formerly the "Comprehensive Annual Financial Report") to January 31, 2022. The completed ACFR must now be submitted to the New Jersey Department of Education **no later than February 5, 2022**.

P.L.2021, c.256 also revised the required certification date for the annual Audit Summary Report (AudSum). Local Education Agencies (LEAs) must access the <u>AudSum Application</u> in the <u>NJDOE Homeroom</u> web portal and certify the report **no later than January 4, 2022**.
