## **We Can! Virtual Career Day for Students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing**

The National Deaf Center on Postsecondary Outcomes Engage for Change State Team for New Jersey is holding a “We Can! Virtual Career Day” on December 2, 2021. The event will be hosted by the Marie H. Katzenbach School for the Deaf. The panelists are Deaf or hard of hearing and represent a variety of careers, such as education and educational support, science and medical fields, leadership, clerical, graphics, counseling, support services, security, maintenance, and more. The panelists are from diverse backgrounds and use various modes of communication.

The “We Can! Virtual Career Day” is designed for high school students in grades 11 and up who are Deaf or hard of hearing. Two separate hour-long sessions will be held, with different panelists each hour.
