Applications for the 2023 Governor's School of New Jersey

The selection process for the prestigious Governor's School of New Jersey has begun. The Office of the Secretary for Higher Education is inviting high school administrators across the State to identify highachieving high school juniors to participate in a summer academic and STEM-focused summer residential program.

There will be two programs operating in 2023. The Governor's School of Engineering and Technology hosted at Rutgers University — New Brunswick from July 2, 2023 – July 28, 2023; and the Governor's School in the Sciences hosted at Drew University from July 16, 2023 – August 5, 2023.

The Governor's School is open to outstanding, high-achieving juniors who are selected by their high schools. School administrators play an instrumental role in identifying and encouraging potential applicants for these programs. As always, this program is free of all tuition and fees.

Please note that applications are due by 11:59 p.m. on January 13, 2023 (Drew University) and January 14, 2023 (Rutgers University-New Brunswick), respectively.

High schools with up to 325 juniors may submit one application for each of the Governor's School programs. High schools that have between 326 and 650 juniors may nominate two applicants, for each of the two programs and high schools with 651 or more juniors may nominate three applicants for each program.
