Virtual Training for State Mandated Language Development Reporting of Preschool-Aged Children Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) Office of Special Education will be providing guidance, by way of virtual training session, for collecting and reporting data on the language development of preschool-aged children who are Deaf or hard of hearing as required by P.L. 2019, Chapter 205. This data collection will begin in June 2022.

Two separate training sessions are being offered virtually:

- Thursday, February 24, 2022 from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.
- Wednesday, March 2, 2022 from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m.
