New Jersey Educator Certification System Launch

On May 31, 2022, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) launched the New Jersey Educator Certification System (NJEdCert), replacing the existing Teacher Certification Information System (TCIS). In addition to extending the call center hours for the Office of Certification, NJEdCert will lead to a more efficient process for timely issuance of certificates as the NJDOE continues to work toward achieving its vision of being a more responsive, forward thinking, and innovative agency.
