- 3) Adhere to the program timelines and eligibility criteria by following the school level instructions to nominate and select one Teacher of the Year and one Educational Services Professional of the Year per school by November 18, 2022;
- 4) Register your Teacher of the Year and Educational Services Professional of the Year by first uploading your completed School Information Form and then completing the fields in the <a href="Meeory of the Year">GEOY online form</a> by December 2, 2022; and
- 5) Notify all nominated educators in your school if they won or not by December 9, 2022.

All registered Teachers of the Year and Educational Services Professionals of the Year will receive a state awards certificate from their County Office of Education.
