Training Opportunities Offered through the Community-Based Instruction Project

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE), in partnership with the Boggs Center on Developmental Disabilities at Rutgers University, is offering training opportunities on Community-Based Instruction (CBI). CBI is an evidence-based practice that supports the successful transition from school to adult life and the full inclusion of students with disabilities in communities. When the community is utilized as a learning environment, it provides practical, meaningful opportunities for students to develop skills in authentic experiences thus promoting greater self-determination, interdependence, and enhanced quality of life in adulthood.

The CBI Project provides a variety of trainings for school personnel aimed at expanding quality implementation and sustainment of CBI across New Jersey. This is achieved through in-person and virtual workshops and community of practice events that address the acquisition, application, and generalization of skills utilized within careers, postsecondary education, and the community while aligning to the New Jersey Student Learning Standards and students' Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals.

This year, training opportunities will include the *Foundations of CBI Training Series for New Personnel*, *Job Coaching for Career Exploration in Community Settings*, *CBI for Younger Students: Building a Foundation for the Future*, *Marketing Matters: Making the Most of CBI through Community Partnerships*, Virtual Community of Practice Sessions and additional supplemental trainings based on the needs of CBI practitioners.
