Peace Islands Institute 2023 Art and Essay Contest

Peace Islands Institute (PII) welcomes submissions for its 13th Annual Art & Essay (A&E) Contest. This year's theme is "The Impact of Social Media on Peace-Building."

Consistent with PII's mission of promoting pluralism and bringing people from different backgrounds together, the A&E Contest aims to: (1) bring middle and high school students from around New Jersey together, (2) promote awareness regarding issues of common concern among New Jersey youth, (3) facilitate their personal and academic growth through a healthy competitive environment, and (4) inspire them to make positive change in their communities.

Peace Islands Institute awarded \$5,600 for the 2022 Art and Essay Contest. The recipients were students who are ranked in the top eight of each of the four contest categories.

Key steps/actions

Students in grades 6-12 from the State of New Jersey are eligible to participate. Each student may submit only one work in each category.

- 1. The participants must send their work by May 14 at 11:59 p.m.
- 2. Winners will be announced on May 30 via the Instagram account and website.
- 3. The awards ceremony time and venue will also be announced via the same platforms.
