## **Certification Regulatory Amendments**

The New Jersey State Board of Education recently adopted regulatory amendments at <u>N.J.A.C. 6A:9</u> Professional Standards, <u>N.J.A.C. 6A:9A</u> New Jersey Educator Preparation Programs, <u>N.J.A.C. 6A:9B</u> State Board of Examiners and Certification, and <u>N.J.A.C. 6A:9C</u> Professional Development. The goals of these amendments are to ensure that every student, school, and local educational agency (LEA) has access to well-trained, effective educators who meet the needs of their communities, and to increase diversity and the supply of educators, while maintaining New Jersey's high standards for educators.

## **Summary of Chapter 9 Amendments**

- Ensure equity and access
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Non-citizen certificate holders may renew certificates up to three times; and
  - Streamlined reciprocity requirements.
- Certification flexibilities
  - Multiple options for candidates to demonstrate basic skills for instructional and Career and Technical Education (CTE) certification;
  - Substitute credential requires 30 semester hours;
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Teaching and out-of-state experience may count toward the CTE substitute credential; and
  - $\circ$  Expanded authorization for bilingual/bicultural endorsement holders.
  - Additional endorsement pathways for currently certified teachers
    - o Streamlined pathway for certified science teachers to seek additional science endorsements; and
      - Middle school teachers can seek middle school with subject-matter specialization in STEM and humanities endorsements.
- New certificates and endorsements (coming soon)
  - Bilingual paraprofessional credential;
  - Early literacy specialist;
  - Computer science;
  - Temporary military spouse;
  - Early college high school; and
  - Alternate-route reciprocity.
