Public Comment on an Amendment to Section D of the American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary Schools Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER) State Plan

As a part of the New Jersey Department of Education's (NJDOE) commitment to providing regular ARP ESSER updates to local educational agencies (LEAs), today the NJDOE is inviting public comment on an amendment to Section D.1 of the ARP ESSER State Plan.

Background

The ARP Act provides an additional \$122 billion in Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ARP ESSER) to States and school districts to help safely reopen, sustain the safe operation of schools, and to address the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the nation's students. The New Jersey <u>ARP ESSER plan was approved</u> by the United States Department of Education (USDE) in August 2021.

In an effort to meet the needs of the State, the NJDOE is amending a smaller portion of its plan in Section D.1 that focuses on how the State is using evidence-based interventions to address the academic impact of lost instructional time. The plan will continue to support the formula grant to LEAs – Accelerated Learning Coaching and Educator Support Grant, and reallocate previously earmarked funds for assessments (Start Strong and Kindergarten Readiness) toward initiatives for bolstering foundational literacy skills in early learners.

Public Comment Process
