2022-2023 Reimbursement for Providing Additional or Compensatory Special Education and Related Services to Students with Disabilities Beyond Age 21

The application for seeking reimbursement for providing Additional or Compensatory Special Education and Related Services (ACSERS) for students with disabilities who were 21 as of July 1, 2022 is available on the New Jersey Department of Education's (NJDOE) <u>Homeroom</u> webpage. Applications for reimbursement of 2022-2023 costs will be accepted through June 23, 2023.

Award notifications will be distributed following the application closure, and payment will be made in July 2023.

If a local educational agency (LEA) submitted estimated costs in December or January, a representative must log in, submit the final costs for the 2022-2023 school year, and certify the final costs for each eligible student. An LEA that provided services to an eligible student under this program, but did not previously submit estimated costs, may also log in, submit, and certify the final costs for services provided in the 2022-2023 school year. Accounting Guidance

ACSERS awards must be recorded in the special revenue fund account 20-4537, line number 827. Expenses must be recorded in the new program code 20-486-xxx-xxx, line number 88712.
