Call for Members for Advisory Panel on Programs Serving 18- to 21-Year-Old Students with Disabilities

The New Jersey Department of Education's Office of Special Education is forming an Advisory Panel for the purpose of reviewing and developing recommendations on Quality Indicators for Programs Serving Students with Disabilities Ages 18-21. The Advisory Panel will be a small group comprised of stakeholders (e.g., educators, parents, researchers, professors, etc.) with experience and expertise in programming for students with disabilities ages 18-21. The quality indicators document will support public school programs with quality programming standards for serving this population of students with disabilities.
