# Graduation Ready Cut Scores Established for the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA): English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics, and Alternative Assessments

On May 3, 2023, the New Jersey State Board of Education approved the proficiency level cut score for the ELA and mathematics components of the NJGPA, as well as the menu of alternative assessments and aligned cut scores. The requirements for the classes of 2024 and 2025 will be available on the <u>Graduation Assessment Requirements</u> webpage.
