Speech and Language Community of Practice

A community of practice (CoP) is a group of learners who share a common interest, meet on a regular basis, and seek to improve their practice (Wenger & Traynor, 2015). Speech language pathologists in schools are responsible for fulfilling students' individualized education programs (IEPs), including assessment, diagnosis, and treatment. The goal of the Speech and Language Community of Practice (Speech and Language CoP) is to bring speech language pathologists and diverse educators together in a working relationship around common interests in the development and implementation of high-quality programming for students with disabilities in New Jersey schools. The Speech and Language CoP will share information to improve practices that lead to positive outcomes for staff and students by meeting three to four times annually at the Central Learning Resource Center (Trenton) to promote group sharing of evidence-based and other best practices, and collaborative problem-solving opportunities. A virtual component may be added to include hybrid meetings to engage additional participants. Speakers from other agencies and organizations will be invited to present information useful to those involved and the communities they serve.

Who should apply?

Speech Language Pathologists and other school professionals who support students with speech and language disorders should consider applying. Members of the Speech and Language CoP will be invited to attend up to four in-person meetings at the <u>Learning Resource Center (LRC) – Central</u> in Trenton.
