New Federal Guidance Urges Expediting ARP-HCY Funds

The United States Department of Education (USED) recently released a <u>Dear Colleague Letter</u> to Chief School Officers urging states to expedite obligating American Rescue Plan Homeless Children and Youth (ARP-HCY) funds by September 30, 2024. These funds provide critical wraparound supports for students experiencing homelessness who have been especially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. USED updated the ARP-HCY allowable uses to meet additional urgent needs.

Maximizing ARP-HCY Funds

It should be noted that any activity allowable under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, is also allowable under the ARP-HCY program. ARP-HCY funds, however, are uniquely flexible to support the identification, enrollment, and school participation of children and youth experiencing homelessness, including wrap-around services. The National Center for Homeless Education (NCHE) has provided a Use of Funds Tip Sheet as additional guidance for local educational agencies to determine whether a proposed use of funds for ARP-HCY grants may be allowable. The Tip Sheet clarifies that ARP-HCY funds may be used for emergency motel stays, transportation needs including the purchase of vehicles, food assistance, early childhood education, among many other uses.

Spending Timeline

ARP-HCY funds must be obligated by September 30, 2024 and liquidated by October 15, 2024.
